Game rules

Number of players: from 4 to 20 people, divided into 4 teams (1-5 people in each team).

Complete set of the game:

Corruption situation cards: Each card describes a specific corruption situation (for example, bribery, abuse of power, embezzlement).

Cards with types of corruption: Cards with the names of types of corruption acts (for example, "Bribery", "Suborning", "Abuse of power").

Timer: Used to track the time to complete tasks.

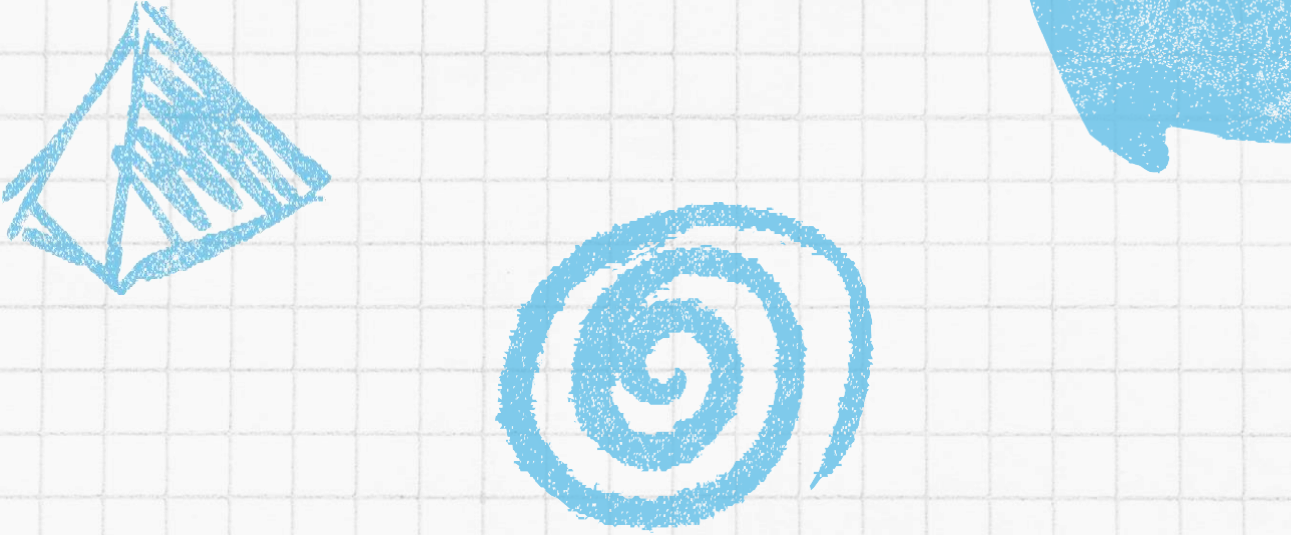
Each team is given a task in turn - 12 cards with a description of the corruption situation and 12 cards with types of corruption are distributed.

The team must quickly determine what kind of action it is and find a suitable card with the type of corruption from their set.

If the team correctly and quickly indicates the type of corruption, it gets a point.

At the end of the game, the number of correct answers in each team is checked

Time limit: Each team has 5 minutes to make a decision and present their cards.

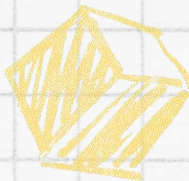
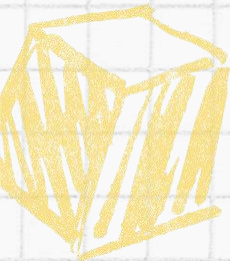


Type of corruption



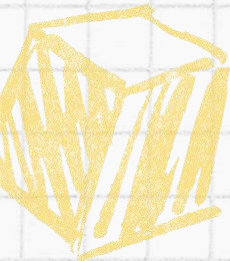
Bribery

Bribery — receiving by an official, as well as giving him a bribe in order to obtain certain benefits in an illegal manner.



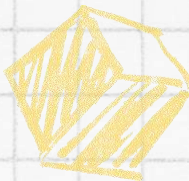
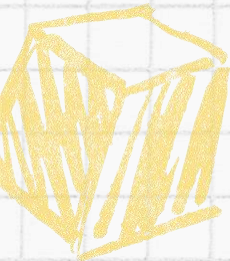
Abuse of power

Abuse of power is the commission by an official who permanently or temporarily performs the functions of a representative of the authorities of an intentional act contrary to the interests of the service using the powers that it is endowed with on the basis of laws and other normative legal



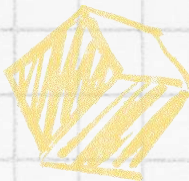
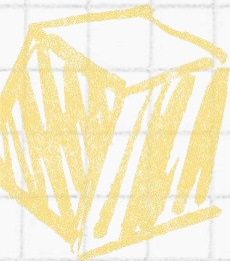
Suborning

offer or promise to an employee of an enterprise, institution or organization who is not an official, or to a person working for the benefit of the enterprise, institution or organization, to provide him (her) or a third party with an illegal benefit



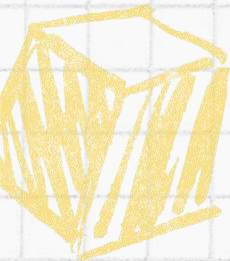
Plundering

Misappropriation, embezzlement of property or taking possession of it through abuse of official position



Fraud

taking possession of someone else's property or
acquiring the right to property by deception or abuse
of trust



Conflict of interest



a situation in which an official, while performing their duties, has a private interest, which, although it does not necessarily lead to making an illegal decision or committing an illegal act, is capable of leading to this.
