What is academic

integrity?

"Academic integrity is the observance by a person who is involved in education and science of all moral ethical and copyright requirements when writing written assignments"

"Be honest and ethical in your studies and research. It includes using only your own ideas and words in your work, passing exams honestly, completing tasks independently, respecting other people's work and ideas and following the rules of the educational institution"

"Corruption in educational institutions, teacher's favorites, callousness to students and educational process"



Definition:

Law of Ukraine "On education" Article
42 paragraph 1

Academic integrity - this is a set of ethical principles and rules defined by law that should guide participants of the educational process during training, teaching and implementation of scientific (creative) activity in order to ensure trust in learning outcomes and/or scientific (creative) achievements

**Violation of the
academic integrity
is considered:**

Law of Ukraine «On copyright and related rights»



Article 53. Ways to secure a claim in cases of violation of copyright and related rights

2. If there is sufficient data on the commission of such a violation of copyright and (or) related rights, for which, in accordance with the law criminal liability is provisioned, the body of pre-trial investigation or the court are required to take measures for

ensuring the search and seizure on:

a) ***copies of works*** (including computer programs and databases), recorded performances, phonograms, videograms, programs of broadcasts in respect of which it is assumed that they are counterfeit, as well as means of bypassing technical means of protection;
B) ***materials and equipment***, intended for their manufacture and

playback;

C) ***documents, invoices, and other items***, which may be evidence of illegal actions being committed.

Honesty is key

norm that requires frankness about your own intellectual contribution.

The student must be truthful and open in their work, avoid plagiarism, and not attribute the results of other people's research to themselves. In addition, it is important to use the sources of information correctly and properly cite them in accordance with the established standards.

Justice is the second

key value of academic integrity. Transparency, openness and elimination of all forms of discrimination or injustice must be guaranteed.



Respect manifests itself in recognizing diversity of views, intellectual property, formulating sound conclusions, and evaluating the contribution of others to scientific progress. Recognition of the intellectual work of colleagues is the foundation of a healthy scientific environment that promotes the development of knowledge and new discoveries.

Trust. It is based on compliance with certain standards: information should be presented honestly and without distortion, and research results should not change in accordance with the author's desired conclusions.

Trust promotes cooperation that,

in turn, facilitates the exchange of knowledge and experience between different organizations in different fields of activity.

05.

Authors of scientific research should carry **responsibility** for the quality and reliability of their work, be aware of their responsibilities and understand the consequences of their actions. They are required to comply with the rules and requirements of academic integrity. The applicant must define a specific goal, develop an action plan, and work independently to achieve their goals.
